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## **Term Time Leave & Fixed Penalty Notices - IMPORTANT**

A new National Framework for Penalty Notices for School Absence will come into effect from the 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024. A penalty notice is an out of court settlement which is intended to cause improved attendance without the need for a criminal prosecution.

From September the Fixed Penalty Notice charge, issued by Cheshire West & Chester Council, will increase to £160 per child per parent (£80 per child per parent if paid with 28 days).

Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice, to the same parents, for the same pupil within 3 years of the first notice, the second notice is charged at a flat rate of £160 per child per parent, if paid within 28 days.

A third penalty notice must not be issued within a 3-year period. Therefore, in cases where the threshold is met for a third (or subsequent) times within those 3 years, alternative action should be taken instead. This will often include considering prosecution but may include other tools such as one of the other attendance legal interventions.

The National Framework aims to:

- **Make penalty notices more effective** by ensuring they are only used in cases where they are the most appropriate tool.
- **Prioritise the support first approach** by expecting support to be used in cases where it is appropriate.
- **Improve consistency in the use of penalty notices across England** by introducing a new national threshold at which they are considered.
- **Improve the deterrent effect of a penalty notice** by increasing the amount and introducing a new national limit of 2 penalty notices within a 3-year period.

#### **Specifically, the National Framework includes:**

- A single consistent national threshold for when a penalty notice must be considered of 10 sessions (usually equivalent to 5 school days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10 school week period.
- This can be made up of a combination of any type of **unauthorised** absence, such as 4 sessions of holiday taken in term time plus 6 sessions of arriving late after the register closes, all taken within any 10-school week period. This will be assessed these as they occur.
- The unauthorised absence sessions can be consecutive (e.g. 10 sessions of holiday in one week) or sporadic (e.g. 6 sessions of unauthorised absence in 1 week and 1 per week for the next 4 weeks).
- The 10-school week period may span different terms or school years (e.g. 2 sessions of unauthorised absence in the Summer Term and a further 8 within the Autumn Term).

## **Collective Worship**

Each Friday our whole school Collective Worship will be a Praise Assembly where children will share their work. This will alternate by Key Stage and be held in the school hall, commencing at approx 9am. We have scheduled some Collective Worship to take place in Church, these will be communicated within this section.

Parents are very welcome to attend all Friday Collective Worship and Church Services.

We do encourage a calm atmostphere in school, particularly in Collective Worship and ask that parents attending remain quiet when the children come into the hall – thank you for your cooperation.
