### Harvest Festival Services

### Attendance Rewards

Since our return in September, we have been reviewing the attendance reward system and will be changing it with immediate effect.

We are no longer presenting gold, silver, and bronze stars each term for achieving over 96% attendance, although the 100% attendance badge for the whole academic year will remain in place, as recognition for this significant achievement.

The star badges will be replaced by an attendance recognition certificate presented to any child, on any given week.

We will review any standout attendance achievements each week, with any identified being acknowledged in Collective Worship on a Friday. This will not necessarily be every week and or for the highest attendance but may acknowledge a child overcoming certain challenges to be present at school.
