Congratulations to Chloe (Y2) who was selected to be flag bearer at the Remembrance Day Parade on Sunday 10th November 2024.

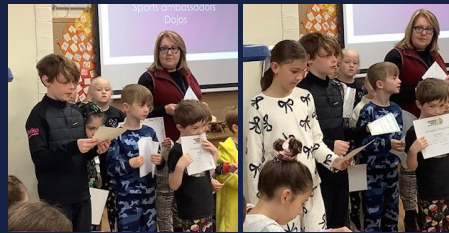


Sport Ambassadors
