FoxHowl/Delamere Residential 3rd - 4th April 2025

We are happy to provide you with details of the 1 night residential booked for your children, taking place in April this year.

The children will travel to the FoxHowl Centre at Delamere on Thursday 3rd April, returning on Friday 4th April 2025.

The residential will be led by Mr Bradley along with 2 other members of staff, who will be confirmed a little nearer the time. The activities will include Jungle Club, Pond/Stream dipping and comparison of habitats. There will also be an evening campfire.

The cost of the trip including the coach is £121.00 per child; this can be paid in three monthly instalments, the first being a non-refundable deposit of £41.00, due by Friday 14th February and followed by two payments of £40.00 or the whole amount.
