Main Road Issues

We have received reports of dangerous overtaking on the main road during drop off & collection times from through traffic. We have reported these many times to the police via our PCSO and the Parish Council.

Whilst we have requested a police presence to monitor, unfortunately, they are unable to attend as often as we, or they, would like, and when they are present, drivers see a police vehicle parked and tend to be a little more mindful of the actions they take.

It has been noted by the PCSO about the poor road markings, and a request has been made to Cheshire West & Chester Council for these to be re-painted. We are unsure if/when this will take place, however, as it is not an offence to overtake by crossing over a broken/dotted white line (which the markings along this stretch of road are) providing it is safe to do so, it is still reliant on drivers making a safe choice/decision.

If you witness dangerous overtaking or any other incidents, please report them to 101, however, they will require a car or vehicle registration number from you. The more people who report incidents, the more weight this will have. School is unable to report as we do not witness these incidents.

Could we also request that all parents are considerate with driving and parking, at afternoon collection, and particularly on a Friday, when there are fewer after school clubs running. We appreciate parents have places to be, however, courtesy on the Cobbles is essential to keep the traffic flowing, both around school and on the main road. If other family members or friends collect on your behalf, we would appreciate it if this were passed onto them. Please also be mindful of your speed on the playground when arriving & departing – thank you.
